INFORMATION TO PASSENGERS:

1. THE ENTRY OR EXIT FROM THE ISLAND ON ALERT LEVEL 3 IS ONLY PERMITTED FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS, REGARDLESS OF THE PLACE OF ORIGIN OR DESTINATION:

- a) Assistance to health centers, services and establishments.
- b) Compliance with labor, professional, business, institutional or legal obligations.
- c) Attendance at university, teaching and educational centers, including nursery schools.
- d) Return to the place of habitual or family residence. This exception includes travel to territories that are the place of habitual residence of family members or persons close to those who travel.
- e) Assistance and care for the elderly, minors, dependents, people with disabilities or especially vulnerable people.
- f) Travel to financial and insurance entities or refueling stations in neighboring territories.
- g) Required or urgent actions before public, judicial or notarial bodies.
- h) Renewals of permits and official documentation, as well as other administrative procedures that cannot be postponed.
- i) Taking official exams or tests that cannot be postponed.
- j) Due to force majeure or situation of necessity.
- k) Passenger in transit in a port or airport of an island on alert level 3 with final destination in another country or another place of the national territory.
- l) Any other activity of a similar nature, duly accredited.

2. OTHER REASONS FOR ENTERING THE ISLAND ON ALERT LEVEL 3

- a) Persons coming from abroad, whatever the reason for the trip, with the following requirements:
 - Public health form called "Health Control Form", through the website www.spth.gob.es, or the Spain Travel Health-SpTH application.
 - Active Infection Diagnostic Test for SARS-CoV-2 with a negative result, carried out within seventy-two hours prior to arrival in the Canary Islands. Tests accepted: PCR (COVID-19 RT-PCR) or Transcription-Mediated Amplification (TMA).
- b) Persons coming from the rest of the national territory, except from the other Canary Islands, whatever the reason for the trip, who prove a reservation in a tourist accommodation establishment registered in the General Tourist Registry of the Autonomous Community of the Canary Islands.

3. INTER-ISLAND TRAVEL:

- a) It will not be possible to travel to an island on alert level 3 from the other Canary Islands, nor to the other Canary Islands from the island on alert level 3, for reasons other than those indicated in section 1, not even in the case of accommodation in a tourist accommodation establishment registered in the General Tourist Registry of the Autonomous Community of the Canary Islands.

b) It is recommended that travelers over 6 years of age who arrive in any of the Canary Islands from island on alert level 3, for any of the reasons indicated in section 1, should take an Active Infection Diagnostic Test for SARS-CoV-2 with negative result, carried out within seventy-two hours prior to arrival at their destination. Accepted tests:

- PCR (COVID-19 RT-PCR).
- Transcription Mediated Amplification (TMA).
- Rapid tests for the detection of SARS-CoV-2 antigens with a specificity of more than 97% and a sensitivity of more than 80%, in accordance with the corresponding approval of a country of the European Union or the European Economic Area;

c) The diagnostic test may also be carried out within 72 hours of arrival, and the passenger must be isolated in his or her residence until a negative result is obtained and sent to the health authority, or until epidemiological discharge, in the event that the test is positive.

d) Inter-island travelers may have the diagnostic test carried out free of charge, at origin or destination in ISLAND ON LEVEL 3, or on any other island, by calling 900112061

4. IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO ENTER OR LEAVE THE ISLAND ON ALERT LEVEL 3 FOR ANY OTHER REASON, FOR OTHER PERSONS, OR FROM OR TO ANY PLACE OF ORIGIN OR DESTINATION OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFIED IN POINTS 1 AND 2 ABOVE.

5. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVIDED MEASURES IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF DECREE LAW 14/2020, OF SEPTEMBER 4, WHICH ESTABLISHES THE SANCTIONING REGIME FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH PREVENTION AND CONTAINMENT MEASURES AGAINST COVID-19 IN THE AUTONOMOUS COMMUNITY OF THE CANARY ISLANDS, WITHOUT IMPAIRMENT OF ANY CRIMINAL LIABILITIES THAT MAY ARISE FROM FALSEHOOD IN THE PRESENT PUBLIC DOCUMENT.
